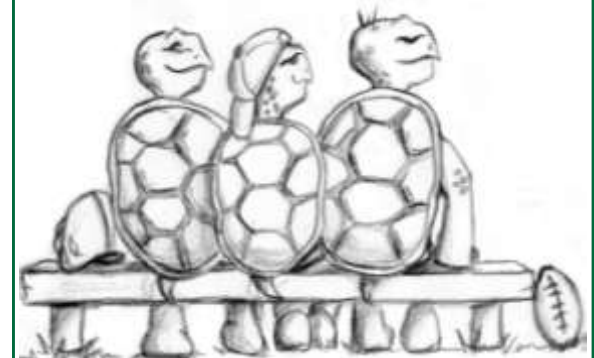

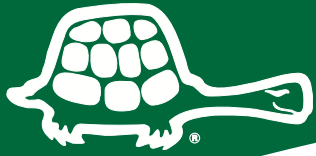

What is Funds for Friends?

A goal of The Greene Turtle is to create long lasting neighborhood partnerships with the hope of nurturing and maintaining a better community.

With that in mind, we established a great **fundraising program in 2005, that's called Funds for Friends.**

In a "Turtle-shell", **Funds for Friends is the team** formed between The Greene Turtle and your organization. This new team then hosts a day-long event to raise money for your cause.

Together, we will schedule that specific day and it will be dedicated as your **organization's day.**



How does Funds for Friends work?

The Funds for Friends experience typically hinges on the number of guests recruited to help celebrate your cause. This is because your organization receives a share of generated money during the entire business day.

The next step requires your group to contact as many friends, families and members to visit The Greene Turtle on that day.



In the past, this has been done easily and effectively through distributing fliers, making phone calls, sending e-mails/newsletters, and announcements at organizational meetings.

Once your Funds for Friends event is over, we calculate 10% of our sales for your entire day. We then gladly donate that amount to **your group's needs and fundraising cause.**
